




Giraffe Manor is set in 12 acres of private land within 140 acres of indigenous forest in the Langata suburb of Nairobi. Giraffe Manor is one of Nairobi's most iconic buildings. The historic manor house has extraordinary appeal, that harks back to the 1930s when visitors first flocked to East Africa to enjoy safaris. With its stately façade, elegant interior, verdant green gardens, sunny terraces and delightful courtyards, guests often remark that it's like walking into the film Out of Africa.

Fun Fact: Giraffe Manor is one of the most instagrammed properties in the world.





Sir David Duncan of the Mackintosh family, famous for 'Mackintosh toffee', built the manor in 1932. He used an architectural design of a Scottish hunting hotel – the west side had a view of Ngong Hills while the south side had a view of Mt. Kilimanjaro. At the time, the manor was on a 150-acre piece of land. He sold it in the 1960s, and the new owner leased it repeatedly until it fell into disrepair. Jock Leslie Melville, the grandson of a Scottish earl, and his American wife Betty, a conservationist, bought it in 1974 as their residence. Not long after the Melville's settled into the manor, they heard Rothschild giraffes were facing extinction due to loss of habitat. Having three giraffes already, they went on to create what we see today. A safety zone for the animals and highly desired holiday destination.

Fun Fact: The first three giraffes names were Tom, Dick and Harry

The manor is an authentic brick building set among lush gardens. There are 12 fully furnished en-suite Rooms varying in set-up to accommodate couples and families alike. Each room has its own personal style with elegant furnishings, art-deco features and four-poster beds. Each room is subtly different in size and design, but all have balconies with twin or double bed options and three have an additional day bed. Huge walk-in rain showers flooded with natural light from above, ample room for reorganizing luggage and space in which to relax come as standard. There is also free Wi-Fi available, toiletries, hair dryer, tea/coffee making facilities, private safe, dressing gowns etc. Pretty much a home from home situation, so relax and enjoy.







From encounters with the world's tallest mammal to exploring local culture, there's plenty to keep you entertained during your stay, both within the manor's grounds and in the local area.

The Retreat at Giraffe Manor provides the perfect beginning or ending to any African safari. Surrounded by nature, it offers an exquisite wellness experience for our Manor House guests as well as a day room facility for guests of The Safari Collection portfolio who require a stopover in Nairobi. Located just 80 metres to the left of the main manor house, it shares the same tranquil outlook over the forested giraffe sanctuary. Designed to pay homage to the original house next door, The Retreat at Giraffe Manor is an elegant mix of open plan indoor and outdoor spaces. High ceilings and impressively large arched windows frame the Manor's iconic herd of giraffes which might be glimpsed loping across the lawns in the distance or at the end of the infinity pool. Our four day bedrooms are all located on the first-floor and a provide peaceful space for those wishing to rest pre and post-travel. Guests are NOT able to stay overnight at The Retreat or visit Giraffe Manor, however our en-suite bedrooms can be booked for the day and provide the ultimate comfort alongside our wellness centre.
