Your Vessel Celebrity Edge

Celebrity Edge's draw lies within its name: It's edgy. Entertainment in the theatre is loud and influenced by today's top hits. Food venues are straight out of any big city, from a grab-and-go gourmet deli and a reservations-only sushi spot to a high-tech French bistro with an animated dining experience you have to see to believe. The cocktails you'll find in the ship's three-deck spiraling restaurant/lounge/theater called Eden are mind-bendingly one-of-a-kind.

The experience on the ship also blends edges -- between indoor and outdoor, between stage and audience. There's so much greenery onboard and so many massive windows, it's easy to feel as though you're outside, even when sitting inside Eden or in your cabin. It's especially true if you're in one of the 918 Infinite Veranda rooms, cabins that can function as an ocean view with solarium with floor-to-ceiling views and air conditioning.

By partnering with designers who had not previously been involved in the cruise industry, they brought to life a completely new and different type of thinking to the ship which was launched in 2018 and helmed by Kate McCue, the first female captain of a cruise ship.

Every inch of the ship, through its unique outward-facing innovation, is designed to bring guests closer to the sea and the destinations they're visiting ... it's a luxury boutique hotel at sea.

Features giving Celebrity Edge the edge include, for suite guests, access to The Retreat "our ship within a ship" with private restaurant and exclusive lounge and sundeck. Guests in the six, two-storey villas enjoy private plunge pools and the Infinite Verandah (also in staterooms) where, with the press of a button, the living space transforms into a balcony.

Edge has 29 bar and dining offerings and menus designed by Michelin-starred chefs while The Spa offers steam, float and salt rooms, heated tile loungers, Peloton bikes and F45 Training.


But it's the Magic Carpet, the world's first cantilevered, floating platform at a height of up to 13 storeys over the sea, that's a point of difference on Edge.

Fort Lauderdale - Cozumel (7-nights)

Inside: You'll find inside cabins spread throughout the ship, ranging in size from 181 square feet (standard) to 202 square feet (deluxe). Both have the same basic layout, with a divan sofa that can be used as a third bed, but the deluxe room has a bigger bathroom and more drawer space.

Ocean View: There are three categories of oceanview stateroom on Celebrity Edge: standard (200 square feet), deluxe (238 square feet) and panoramic (212 square feet). All can hold three to four people. All the Panoramic ocean-view rooms, which have wall-sized floor-to-ceiling windows are on Deck 6.

Balcony: You'll find a limited number of true balcony staterooms on Edge, in two categories: Deluxe (202 square feet with a 40-square-foot balcony) and Sunset Veranda (228 square feet with an 89-square-foot balcony). Deluxe veranda rooms are located at either end of the ship and resemble all other standard cabins in terms of layout and amenities.

Activities & Amenities Include

Pools

Celebrity Edge has one long all-access pool, located smack-dab in the middle of Deck 14. The pool is flanked by hundreds of lounge chairs, with many facing out toward the ocean.

A deck up, on what Celebrity has dubbed the Resort Deck, passengers can relax in one of Edge's two martini-glass shaped hot tubs.

For adults only, the solarium offers serene pool time under a unique geodesic dome. The area has a wonderfully large pool flanked by a giant hot tub.

Finally, The Retreat area has its own pool, located on Deck 16. This area is open exclusively to passengers staying in the ship's suites. The large pool is the centerpiece of the outdoor space.

Spa

Celebrity Edge's spa is gorgeous and features some of the most high-tech treatments available at sea -- it's also one of the most expensive we've ever come across. Facials (of which there are only a few options) start at \$140 and massages start at \$170.

Fitness

Celebrity Edge offers one of the best and most comprehensive gyms we've ever seen on a cruise ship. The space, located on Deck 15 forward, has much of the same equipment you'd find at your land-based health club.

Kids

Camp at Sea provides a packed program of entertainment for little ones with the fun kicking off at 9 a.m. every day and going on till 10 p.m.

Teens

Aptly-named, The Basement is the dedicated space for teens onboard Edge Class, deep down on Deck 2, right before Destination Gateway.

Casino Bar (Deck 4): Unlike most casino bars, this is not deep in the middle of the Casino but in its own spot accessible from a walkway running past the Grand Plaza.

At Night

Nighttime on Celebrity Edge is all about entertainment, whether in the theater, Eden, the Rooftop Garden or The Club.

You'll also find live music in the early evening at the Sunset Bar and in the Grand Plaza before and after dinner.

Magic Carpet (Decks 2, 5, 14): While the Magic Carpet serves different purposes depending on where it's positioned on the ship, it always has one thing in common -- the bar is always open!

Your Cruise itinerary

Day 1 – Fort Lauderdale, Florida, USA

Miles of broad white sandy beaches, dozens of lush green golf courses, and Caribbean cruises awaits you at Fort Lauderdale. You can head out to the Everglades and enjoy Flamingo Gardens, home to pink flamingos, snarling alligators, black bears, and Florida panthers, exotic trees, butterfly gardens, and native flowers. You will find a wide choice of cuisine, such as a fusion of old Florida favorites with new Caribbean influences and plenty of local seafood, including lobster, grouper, mahi-mahi, pompano, snapper, tuna, and stone crabs.

Day 2 – Key West

The Florida Straits barrier stretches 170 miles up the coast of crystal-clear waters, where you can enjoy shark and wildlife tours. The tour operators deploy a scent to attract these apex predators right next to the boat. You will also get to see stingrays, dolphins and birds. If you opt for snorkeling you will get to see yellowtail snappers, blue tang, sea turtles, tuna and more. Located in Mallory Square, is the Key West Aquarium is one of the island's most popular attractions for people of all ages. Home to alligators, jellyfish, sharks and many other marine animals, guests can enjoy interactive conservation talks as well as animal feedings as well as having the unique opportunity to meet live sharks and stingrays.

Day 3 - At Sea

The Resort Deck lection of 500 activities to work with, including Xbox One X. Youth Counselors design daily programs that keep everyone excited and engaged, one for kids and one for teens called the basement.

Day 4 – Costa Maya, Mexico

Because we are so close to the Sian Ka'an nature reserve, visitors to Costa Maya can get to see many types of wildlife. Howlers (sounding like King Kong) live quite high in the jungle trees, so you are only going to find them in the forest canopy. They seldom come down out of the trees, living most of their lives in the tree-tops. More common are spider monkeys and can be found at Uyumil Che (nicknamed the "Monkey Farm"), a foundation dedicated to returning tamed spider monkeys into the wild.

Day 5 - Cozumel, Mexico

In 1961, the famous Jacques Yves Cousteau came to Cozumel to film a documentary. Since then, Cozumel has consistently been on the top of many diving lists among diver's destinations. It's vast coral heads, brilliant sponges, hundreds of tropical fish, rich ecosystems and steep walls that sink into the abyss. Tunnels and caves twist through the reef, providing a rich environment for many species, including some not found anywhere else on earth.

Cozumel is world-renown to be part of the second largest barrier reef system in the world and is considered some of the best wall diving in the world. The average diving visibility is more than 40 meters and vertically drops off to the deep blue abyss. If scuba diving is not your thing, snorkeling in the crystal-clear waters of the Caribbean and inland Cenotes near Playa del Carmen make snorkeling an exciting and unforgettable experience for the whole family, and does not require special training, only the ability to swim, so it can be enjoyed by all ages.

Day 6 – Grand Cayman

The appearance of the turtle on the Cayman Islands' flag, seal and currency reflects the close association the people have to the turtle. Learn all about turtles and how the Cayman Turtle Centre is preserving this endangered species. As you start your adventure, your first encounter will take you within feet of some of the most majestic and ancient animals in the world. The Genesis Pond is home to Green Sea Turtles who have matured and are at or near the age to start reproducing; which is usually at about 16 years of age. Turtles return to the nesting beaches of their mothers and grandmothers. The beach at the edge of the pond allows female turtles to nest in an environment very similar to the ones they would nest in if they were in the wild. Green Sea Turtles are the largest of the hard-shelled sea turtles and the second largest of all turtle species. The Turtle Touch & Wading Tanks will allow you to see yearling turtles swimming and playing. Reach in to touch or pick one up for a photo of a lifetime. Visit the Education Centre to learn more about the turtles and Caymans history. You can also view turtle hatchery where during breeding season (May – October) you can witness new hatchlings making their way up through the sand of their incubation boxes.

Day 7 - Fort Lauderdale - Disembark
