The story of Peter Rabbit originated from a series of letters written by Beatrix Potter to help cheer up her late Governess' son, Noel, who was often ill. These letters, which began in 1893, were tales written after Potter's real-life pet rabbit named Peter.

In England's Lake District, Peter Rabbit, his cousin Benjamin Bunny, and triplet sisters Flopsy, Mopsy and Cottontail, spend most of their days picking on poor old Mr. McGregor, who had killed and eaten their father, and stealing vegetables from his garden. As the story unfolds it has drawn in young audiences for decades and one would assume for many decades to come too.



About Beatrix Potter

Beatrix Potter, the writer of one of the most beloved children's books of all time, *The Tale of Peter Rabbit* (1902), was a woman of immense talent, indefatigable spirit, and generous heart. Helen Beatrix, the eldest of the two children of Rupert and Helen (Leech) Potter, was born on 28 July 1866 at 2 Bolton Gardens, South Kensington, London. Although Beatrix and her brother, Walter Bertram (1872-1918), grew up in London, both were deeply influenced by long family holidays in the countryside, first in Scotland and later in the English Lake District, and by their northern roots.


Beatrix also wrote picture letters to children she knew and in 1901 she turned one into her first book, *The Tale of Peter Rabbit*, and produced her own privately printed edition of it. The idea had been turned down by several commercial publishers, but Frederick Warne published it in 1902 after Beatrix agreed to redo her black-and-white illustrations in colour. The rest as they say is history and Peter shot Beatrix on the path to a legendary status.
