# The Harbour Grand Hotel Kowloon

Featuring an outdoor pool and a free area shuttle service, Harbour Grand Hong Kong is a 2-minute walk from Fortress Hill MTR Station. Overlooking the beautiful Victoria Harbour, the rooms offer free Wi-Fi and wired internet access. The hotel is 2 MTR stations from Causeway Bay and about 29 km from Chek Lap Kok International Airport.

All guestrooms at Hong Kong Grand Harbour feature modern décor and panoramic city or harbour views. A flat-screen cable/satellite TV, minibar and DVD player are included. 24-hour room service is provided.

All guests can enjoy a free Skyline Pavilion Tour on the 42nd floor every evening from 17:45 to 21:00. Boasting a panoramic view in premium location, guests can enjoy not only the world-renowned Victoria Harbour view but also the romantic sunset view and “A Symphony of Lights”. Guests can take a dip in the 27 m outdoor pool or visit the spa for pampering massage services. Daily workouts can be maintained at the fitness centre. Harbour Grand also provides a tour desk and concierge services. Le 188° Restaurant & Lounge serves European cuisine and seafood. Cantonese dishes are served at Kwan Cheuk Heen Restaurant. Other dining options include Harbour Grand Café and Nagomi Japanese Restaurant.

Harbour Grand Hong Kong Hotel serves buffet breakfast in the morning. Enjoy a visit to Harbour Grand Cafe restaurant which offers international cuisine. You can try cocktails, tea and fresh coffee at the lounge bar. Fortress Hill underground station is nearly a 5-minute walk away. It takes 15 minutes by car to reach Hong Kong H K Heliport airport. An airport transfer and babysitting are available for an extra fee. Guests of Harbour Grand Hong Kong Hotel have free access to a massage therapy and a spa therapy on-site. It features a swimming pool and full spa for your leisure time.



**DAY ONE Yokohama (Tokyo), Japan DEPARTS 05:00 PM**

Tokyo is the largest city on earth and packed with some of the world's best shops, museums and restaurants, big and small. Osaka has its attractions and interesting things to do. Sumo wrestlers wait for trains, reeking of chanko-nabe (traditional sumo food; pure energy and calories), just daring the official railway pushers to push them. Yakuza (Japanese gangsters) get train cars to themselves, but if you get on with them, it's like you're invisible. Busy markets, the visual noise of neon and nonstop action on shopping streets offer insight into the energy and ambition of Osaka.

**DAY FOUR - AT SEA**

**DAY FIVE Naha, Japan ARRIVES 08:00 AM DEPARTS 06:00 PM**

Naha, the capital of Japan's Okinawa Prefecture and its biggest city, also serves as the region's key political, economic and transportation hub. With a fascinating past as the capital of the Ryukyu Kingdom and a working port that dates back to the 15th century, this city of 300,000 residents manages to be both a compelling city and a laid-back one.
