DAY 1 Departs 5PM

Easygoing San Diego embodies the Southern California surfer town fantasy, with its more than 300 days of sun, mild year-round temperatures and accessible, sporty pastimes and tourist attractions. You can hike the Torrey Pines State Natural Reserve to get a glimpse of whale migrations, go sailing in the bay and, of course, surf the famous swells of Del Mar, Oceanside and La Jolla (among many other superb spots). But the sixth-largest city in the United States is surprisingly nuanced, with distinctive neighborhoods: Old Town, North Park, Point Loma and Coronado are all within a few miles of the port, while the bustling Gaslamp Quarter and Little Italy are within walking distance. **WORLD-FAMOUS SAN DIEGO ZOO**. This is your chance to enjoy the world-famous San Diego Zoo. Built on a hillside in beautiful Balboa Park, the zoo boasts the largest collection of flora and fauna in the United States. You will see the giant pandas and koalas housed in enclosures built to look exactly the way the animals live in the wild.

DAY 2 AT SEA

Tomorrow, you land in Mexico so relax and unwind enjoying all the benefits of this fine vessel. Getting to know your ship will prove exciting enough so explore and take it all in.

DAY 3 ARRIVE IN CABO SAN LUCAS MEXICO

Los Cabos doesn't exude the same kind of charm as many other areas of inland Mexico do, but its twin towns—San José del Cabo and Cabo San Lucas don't seem to mind, and neither do visitors, who are drawn here less for traditional Mexican culture than for the sun, the sand and the opportunity to just slow down and relax. Los Cabos—or the Capes—sits at the southernmost tip of the Baja California Peninsula, a narrow strip of land whose varied geography, both above and underwater, makes for plenty of interesting activities and some unusual ones, too. Did you ever think you'd ride a camel in Mexico? You can do that here, or enjoy more predictable pursuits including fishing, golfing and whale-watching. Want something still more laid-back? Visit picture-perfect El Arco, an arch that may look familiar thanks to its cameo on postcards and tourism advertisements. North of the capes, you can drop by the famed Hotel California. And if you've worked up an appetite, you won't be disappointed: Los Cabos offers plenty to enjoy at the table as well, with farm-fresh fruits and vegetables and, of course, seafood being the mainstays here.

DAY 4 MAZATLAN

Mazatlán is a pleasant port city in the Mexican state of Sinaloa, where the best of traditional Mexican architecture, food and culture is found alongside contemporary conveniences, amenities and... **COLONIAL VILLAGES OF THE SIERRA MADRE** Embark on a full-day tour of three traditional villages. Your tour begins with a panoramic drive into the foothills of the rugged Sierra Madre mountains. Your first stop is at a small town called Malpica. Leave the coach and stroll through utterly charming narrow streets, past age-old homes whose stories are long and, thanks to Malpica's isolated location, relatively serene. **MAZATLAN SPORTFISHING** In the waters off Mazatlán, marlin run from November to May and sailfish from April to November. This is an ideal location for old pros to try their luck at fishing, and for hopeful beginners to experience the thrill of a catch.

DAY 5 PERTO VALLARTA ARRIVE 8:00 am

Unique compared to Acapulco, Cancún, Zihuantanejo and several other coastal resort towns in Mexico—many of which were created by the government as planned communities—Puerto Vallarta ("PV" to locals),... **PUERTO VALLARTA HIGHLIGHTS: OLD TOWN, CATHEDRAL & SHOPPING.** Transfer to the Old Town of Puerto Vallarta and pass through its quaint cobblestone streets. You will visit City Hall and the Cathedral of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Admire the elegant residential area of Concha's Chinas and some upscale hotels. At the south end of town, stop for photos at a charming restaurant. Enjoy a beverage here and some free time for shopping. Guests who wish to stay in town to shop or explore independently are welcome to do so but must make their own way back to the ship. **PUERTO VALLARTA SIGHTS: OLD TOWN, CATHEDRAL & TEQUILA DISTILLERY**

Visit the must-see landmarks of Puerto Vallarta. You will begin with a stroll to the Pitillal neighborhood's main square, passing the church and the marketplace, and see the upscale Marina Vallarta residential district. From here, a 15-minute drive brings you to downtown Puerto Vallarta. Walk the famous waterfront Malecon (promenade) and visit the Cathedral of Our Lady of Guadalupe. In the Old Town, your guide leads you on a walk through the colorful streets. Step inside for some retail therapy at Taxco Exporta - Vallarta's newest destination for original silver from Taxco, as well as for tequilas and great Mexican artifacts and gifts. Savor fantastic views over the Bay of Banderas and 30 minutes of free time to purchase a beverage (at your own expense) at El Set restaurant; visit a family-operated tequila distillery. You are welcome to sample some tequilas and purchase a bottle to take home.

DAY 6 and Day 7 AT SEA

Time to really relax and enjoy all the on boards facilities and entertainment after an action-packed Mexican Adventure. until finally arrive back at San Diego at 7:00am to depart.

Your Cabin

Each room includes a flat-screen TV with interactive menu of programming including; on-demand movies, music stations, as well as both live and pre-recorded television. Additionally, guests can access ship information, dining options, an onboard activities schedule, shore excursions, and port information through this interactive media console. There are no external inputs available such as A/V or HDMI.


